Questions

- What do you think of Luke?
- ▶ What will Luke and his friends think of her if she chooses to sleep with him while his friends are watching?
- What will they think of her if she says 'no'?
- What risks is she placing herself under?
- ▶ Where does this leave their relationship?
- What would you do if someone was pressurising you to do something sexually that you didn't want to do?
- If you could give Candice advice what would it be?
